

Woodworker Guidelines for “Crafts & Coffee” Craft Fair

What: Free to the public craft fair. Woodworkers may bring their projects for display and/or sale

When: Beginning September 11, 2010, and every Saturday thereafter, from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm

Where: All three Woodworkers Source stores (Phoenix, Tempe, & Tucson)

If you wish to display (or sell) your projects, please follow these guidelines:

- Sign up in advance at the store to reserve space - space is limited
- Participants are responsible for their own table(s), chair(s), and shade if they want it
- You may sell finished woodwork if you choose; only hand crafted woodwork please, such as turned pens and bowls, furniture, jewelry boxes, etc. Not allowed for sale: raw wood products (blanks, lumber, etc.), tools, woodworking supplies. No exceptions
- If you do sell your projects, sales tax is your responsibility (you will need a city tax license)
- We will promote this to the general public through the newspaper
